




Around the Cairngorms National Park

ITINERARY

Day 1

You will make your own way to Bonnie Scotland and your chauffeur guide will meet you in Inverness or Aviemore. You'll settle into your comfortable accommodation in Aviemore where we are staying for the next two nights.

Day 2

Highland Estates and their workings are a vital part of the Cairngorms National Park and today we visit one of the Cairngorms' Estates and explore it in the company of one of the Laird's team.

In the afternoon, we stretch our legs and walk around a picturesque lochan before watching the sunset over Cairngorm mountain.

Day 3

This morning we bid farewell to the bustling town of Aviemore and take the high road to Malt whisky country. On the way, we stop at a castle whose history dates back to the 1600's. We arrive in the highest village in Scotland and enjoy lunch and a tour of a world-famous distillery; having a chauffeur will mean that you can enjoy the generous tastings! In the late afternoon we travel into Royal Deeside, where we stay for the next two nights.

Day 4

After a hearty breakfast, we stroll around a picturesque Victorian village, visit one of the famous suspension bridges over the River Dee and enjoy a tasting lunch of the finest local ingredients.

In the afternoon, we visit the village church which frequently welcomes royal visitors and spend time in a 17th century castle. A drive out to a famous landmark on the Upper Dee provides us with an opportunity to enjoy the early evening air and to work up a good appetite for dinner!

Day 5

We start the day by exploring the River Dee to the east, following the line of the old railway, as far as a delightful coffee shop and traditional cheese dairy. We head back to the village for lunch and then follow the old route through the Spittal of Glenshee and on to Blair Atholl, where we are staying for our last two nights.

Day 6

The impressive Blair Castle has a long history dating back to 1269, and it sits prominently in the heart of Highland Perthshire. We enjoy a leisurely morning exploring its history, from its cold medieval beginnings to a Victorian castle in the baronial style.

After a scrumptious lunch, we're stretching our legs on a gentle stroll into nearby Glen Tilt and explore a working mill, which also serves up some delicious home baking.

Day 7

Depending on your departure time, we'll spend some more time exploring the beautiful landscape and sites of the Big Tree Country before heading back to Aviemore or Inverness.
